

PARENT/SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

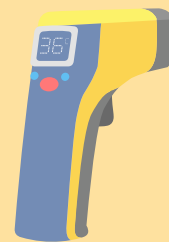
Two spectators are allowed per player, but we are asking families to designate one person to consistently drop off their child, when possible, to reduce the number of unique individuals present at each session. Masks are required at all times.

Check-in will be located at the entrance of the field, on the sideline and will be staggered by age group. We will place cones 6ft apart and ask players/families to remain distant during check in. Social distancing on the sideline will be monitored.

We encourage parents and guardians to:

- Minimize the time they take saying goodbye to allow for more space
- Maintain physical distance with other parents/guardians and participants
- Wear a face covering when approaching the session location
- Wash hands before attending sessions

We ask that you confirm the absence of COVID-19 symptoms, as laid out by the CDC, with your child before arrival. If you or your child has come into contact with anyone experiencing symptoms within the past 14 days, we ask that you stay home.



PARTICIPANT EXPECTATIONS

- Participants will be screened and temperature checked upon arrival at each session
- Participants are required to wear face coverings at all times, except when on the playing field
- Our coaches will provide hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes to participants and ask them to use it on their hands and personal items upon arrival
- Participants MUST bring their own water marked with their name. Team water for sharing through disposable cups or bottles is not allowed and water fountains should not be used/will likely be turned off.
- Avoid shaking hands, fist bumps, or high fives before, during or after practices. Limit unnecessary physical contact with teammates, coaches and spectators.



COACH/STAFF EXPECTATIONS

- Coaches and staff will wear masks at all times and are required to follow the same screening protocol as players
- Social distancing is to be followed by coaches/staff at all times
- Staff will disinfect all shared equipment immediately after each session





COVID-19 SCREENING MEASURES

All participants and staff must fill out our COVID-19 Disclosure, Acknowledgement, and Waiver form prior to participating in their first session of the season. This form encourages participants and staff to self-report and refrain from attending sessions if they are feeling sick or have received a positive COVID-19 test.

All participants and coaches/staff will be screened during check-in at each session by Play Rugby's COVID compliance staff member. They will receive a temperature check via a temporal thermometer and be asked the following questions:

- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Have you had close or proximate contact with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case in the past 14 days?
- Other than New York City, have you travelled anywhere in the past 14 days that has been considered by the New York or United States governments to be a COVID-19 "restricted state"? (List will be updated and made available prior to each session)
- Are you exhibiting any of the following new or worsening symptoms of possible COVID-19?
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Chills
 - Repeated shaking with chills
 - Muscle Pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
 - Feeling Feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit

If a participant or staff should have a positive screening, by responding "yes" to any of the screening questions or receiving a temperature reading of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, they will be sent home immediately and asked not to return for 14 days or until they have proof of a negative COVID-19 test that can be produced to a Play Rugby staff member.

EMERGENCY PLANS & RESPONSE

We will notify all parents/guardians via email and text message if any of the following situations arise:

- A participant tests positive for COVID-19
- A staff member tests positive for COVID-19
- A family member of a participant or staff member tests positive for COVID-19

If any of these situations should occur, there will be a mandatory 14-day quarantine period for all participants and staff members. All activities will be suspended until the 14-day time period has been reached. All permitting agencies where sessions are being held will be notified of positive tests as soon as practicable, no later than 24 hours after Play Rugby knows about the results
